Entry Fee: \$150.00 A & B Class, \$125.00 C Class. Current AMA membership is required (memberships available at sign-up). Must be at least 16 years of age. \$30.00 late registration after May 1. \$30.00 Team Entry Fee

Entry fee, lunch on the trail Saturday and Sunday, rider banquet, MK200 Rider Tee shirt, straight gas or Premix (brand to be announced)

Awards & Classes: A category classes: Teams, 0-125, 126-200cc, 201cc-250 cc, 251cc-open, 4-stroke (open), 40 - 59 (open), 60 & over (open)
B category classes: Teams, 0-200cc, 201cc-250 cc, 251cc-open, 4-stroke (open), 50 & over (open)
C category classes: Teams, Open, 60 & over (open), Women (open)

Except for Women's classes, if there are less than 10 entries in a class it may be merged into the next applicable class (eg. 0-200 into 201-250 or 4-stroke into applicable displacement). Awards will be to three places, but not to exceed 50% of the participants in the class. Each rider will qualify for only one individual award. A rider receiving an award for overall will not also receive a class award although still ranked in that class.

MK200 Home Base: The event will be home based at King's Hideaway Cafe. Banquet tickets will be pre-sold on your entry form, additional tickets later can be purchased directly from the cafe. The end of the first day and the start of the second day will be somewhere on the Saddle Road. The bikes will be impounded and guarded overnight. You are responsible for your own transportation to and from this location. Drive takes about 1 hour one way.

Starting Positions: Assigned by random drawings on April 1st and May 1st. Late entries received after May 1st will be assigned positions as they arrive. Your entry must be received by us by the date of the drawing to qualify for that drawing. It is not essential that teams ride on the same minute. If you wish to do so, enclose three entries under the same cover so that they may be drawn together and assigned the same number. Full refunds will be made until May 15th, partial refunds thereafter. Schedule and final instructions will be mailed as soon as they are available, after the final drawing to all entries. Note! For a team entry to ride together on the same minute all three completed and paid entries must be received together in the same envelope, otherwise you may have to ride on split minutes. Incomplete entries will be returned.

When/where: **Friday May 22, 12:00am-5:00pm** - Check-in and bike tech inspection. Impound at King's Hideaway Cafe. All bikes must be checked in by 5:00, and remain in the impound until the start. Gas will be available until 3:00 only. Fill up early. **5:00pm** - Immediately after closing of sign-up. Rider's Meeting at King's Hideaway Cafe. All riders, and guests desiring access to restricted areas must be present.
Saturday May 23, 5:30am - Impound opens. **6:30am** - Suggested time to leave the impound on your own time to get to the Keaau's Shipman Park start. No gas here. Gas is at the trail start. Make sure to gas up on Friday. **7:00am** - Trail Start keytime at Shipman Park in Keaau. Gas will be available. **P.M.** - 1st day finish on the mountain - 30-40 mile, one hour drive from Hilo.

Sunday May 24, 8:00am - Restart on the mountain. **P.M.** - Finish - Keaau's Shipman Park. **6:00pm** - Awards Banquet at King's Hideaway Cafe.

Security: Bikes will be guarded at impound areas from check-in until the start, at the mountain, and at the cafe impound until Monday morning May 25th. Course: The course uses public roads, therefore all bikes must be street legal. The Rules of the event are basically along AMA guidelines with modifications for local needs.
