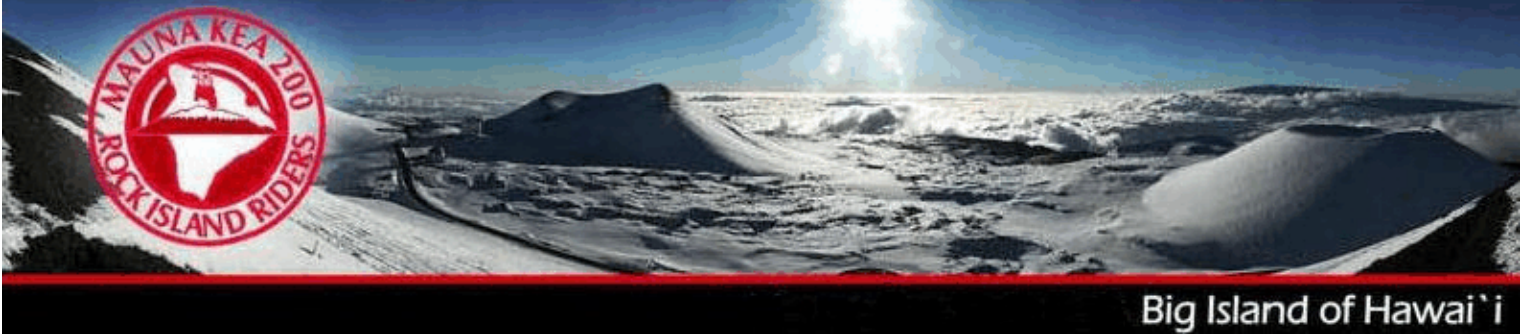


MAUNA KEA "200" - Motorcycle & ATV Race



RIDER REGISTRATION FORM - Information - Page 1 of 4

DATE: Registration/Rider's Meeting - 5:00pm May 22, 2009 / Event - May 23 & 24, 2009

COST: Early registration (by 4/30/09) - Adults \$100, Youth \$50, Guardian Rider \$50. Late registration - 50% additional.

EVENT DESCRIPTION: Up to a 165 mile cross country ride for 'street legal' motorcycles riding both days and a 45 mile ride for all motorcycles and ATVs over rough terrain on Sunday. Course is over minimally maintained trails and "jeep" roads. Riders will race against the clock. Elapsed time from start to finish of each section or segment determines the score. The event will consist of two separate sections with separate awards. The combination of the times for both sections will determine the over-all results. There is the forest section on Saturday and the mountain section on Sunday. Street legal bikes can ride both sections. Non street legal bikes and ATVs ride only the mountain section. Youth class rides only the mountain section. Race headquarters will be at Mauna Kea State Park (MKSP). Food concessions and entertainment and awards ceremony will be on Sunday. Headquarters will be established Saturday afternoon.

On 6:00 pm Friday, May 22 a sign-up, mandatory rider's meeting and late registration will be at the Mooheau Band Stand in downtown Hilo, by the bus station.

Saturday will be a course for street legal motorcycles up to 120 miles in length. It will start at Upper Waiakea ATV/Dirt Bike Park off Stainback Highway and will finish at a rock quarry at about the 18 mile point on Saddle Road. It will include several separate loops with connecting trail. B class riders may ride a shorter course. The rider alone will be responsible for keeping track of where to go next, including the number of times in the loops. There will be a series of numbered, manned check points along the way. Riders will proceed from check point #1 to #2, to #3 and so forth until arriving at the finish of the segment or section. Signs on the course will identify the direction of travel for the next check point. To assist in keeping track of your progress we will use enduro type score cards on the front fender.

Sunday start and finish will be at Mauna Kea State Park. There will be a 8 mile motor on the unopened new Saddle Road alignment to Kilohana where the timed trail start will be staged.

NO BEGINNERS. Medical insurance will not be provided. If a rescue is required (eg. helicopter or ambulance), participant will be responsible for all costs.

RIDING NUMBERS: Riding numbers will be assigned from 1 to 150 based on the order of entry. ABC will not be used. All motorcycles must have front, left and right plate numbers. Quads are permitted to have only two plates. This requirement will be enforced at the tech inspections. At the starting lines, lower numbers have precedence over higher numbers and will be allowed to enter the chute first. Riding numbers will be assigned and posted on the web site. No numbers are being sold this year at registration. Bring your own.

GAS CHECKS: Gas checks will be located within 40 miles of the start, finish or another gas check. Saturday has one gas location that you will visit multiple times. There will be two gas checks locations on Sunday. The approximate mileages are: MKSP to Gas #1 - 8 miles. Gas #1 to Gas #2 - 35 miles. Gas # 2 to Finish - 10 miles. We recommend 2ea 2.5 gal cans on each day.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS: * Water and jacket recommended. * Gas must be in DOT approved fuel containers in like-new condition, clearly marked with your rider number. * 3 number plates for motorcycles, 2 for quads. * US Forestry approved spark arrestor mufflers are an absolute must! * Street legal motorcycle required if you are riding the 1st section in the forest. *

Appropriate rider apparel, helmet, gloves, long sleeve jersey, riding pants and boots. All machines will have to be tech inspected before being allowed in the starting line. A sticker will be applied by the tech inspector to indicate a successful inspection.

CLASSES: * A Motorcycle Class - Expert Class (Mountain and forest sections), * B Motorcycle Class - Amateur Class (Mountain and forest sections), * C Motorcycle Class - Youth class, riders under the age of 15. An accompanying riding guardian is required. (Mountain section only), * A ATV Class - Expert (Mountain section only), * C ATV Class - Youth class, riders under the age of 15. An accompanying riding guardian is required. (Mountain section only)

SPECIAL AWARDS: * Makule (55 years of age and older), * Women's

TIMES: The exact times may be changed, but the following times can be used as a guide. There will be no other sign-up location or time; all registration will be on Friday only!

* Sign-up, Rider's Meeting 6:00pm, Friday, May 22. Following the meeting late entry payments will be accepted at 447 Kalaniana'ole Ave. (County rules do not permit monetary transactions at the meeting facility)

* Saturday Tech Inspection 7:00am, start 8:00am. Bring your gas cans to the start. This will also be the location of the day's gas checks.

* Gas can drop off for Sunday will be at Mauna Kea State Park Saturday afternoon after 4:00pm or Sunday morning prior to 6:00am.

* Sunday Tech Inspection 7:00am, start 8:00am.

No transportation will be provided. You will need a support crew to drive your vehicle to the mountain and you will drive your street legal motorcycle to the start of the mountain section which will start and end at Mauna Kea State Park.

**THIS IS A RELEASE & WAIVER OF LIABILITY & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT
PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING**

I (we), the undersigned, do hereby declare and acknowledge that I (we) are fully aware of the type of terrain, conditions, hazards and obstacles involved in motorcycle events and the risk to life and limbs (death & injury) that is always present in such events. I (we) know the risks of danger to myself and my property while participating in the event and while upon the event premises and, relying upon my own judgment and ability, assume all such risks of loss and hereby agree to reimburse all cost to those persons or organizations connected with this event for damages incurred from my negligence.

I (we) hereby give up all of my rights to sue or make any claim whatsoever and do indemnify and hold harmless the State of Hawai'i, Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, County of Hawai'i, United States Army and all land owners and lessees, etc. used in this event, Rock Island Riders, their agents, officers, members, employees, contractors, lessees and their heirs or assigns from and against any and all loss, liability, claims, demands or causes of actions of any nature whatsoever arising out of the entry into this event.

I (we) also release the above organizations from any damages to or theft of my (our) motorcycle or its accessories, whether by fire, accidents or any other causes during, before or after the event. It is further understood that I (we) accept all risks inherent in these events and all risks which exist.

Furthermore, I (we) understand and agree that in the event I am injured from whatsoever cause during the event, I (we) hereby consent to and authorize aid and ambulance service as needed and agree to hold all parties harmless from any consequences of said aid. I agree that I will be responsible for the cost of said aid.

I (we) agree to comply with all rules and sanctions of the organizers of this event. I (we) also release the above organizations of all responsibility for any and all violations of county, state, or federal laws I (we) may knowingly or unknowingly violate.

I (we) also assume full responsibility for any and all damages and injuries caused by myself, my rider or passenger, or agent, representative or servant acting on my behalf during, before and after the days of the event.
