**Measure Title:** RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

**Report Title:** Motor Vehicle Registration

**Description:** Defines "aftermarket motorcycle frame" and allows the county director of finance to assign a vehicle identification number to a motorcycle with an aftermarket frame. Except for special interest vehicles, reconstructed vehicles, and motorcycles with an aftermarket frame, disallows the registration of uncertified motor vehicles and devices. (SB1325 HD1)
