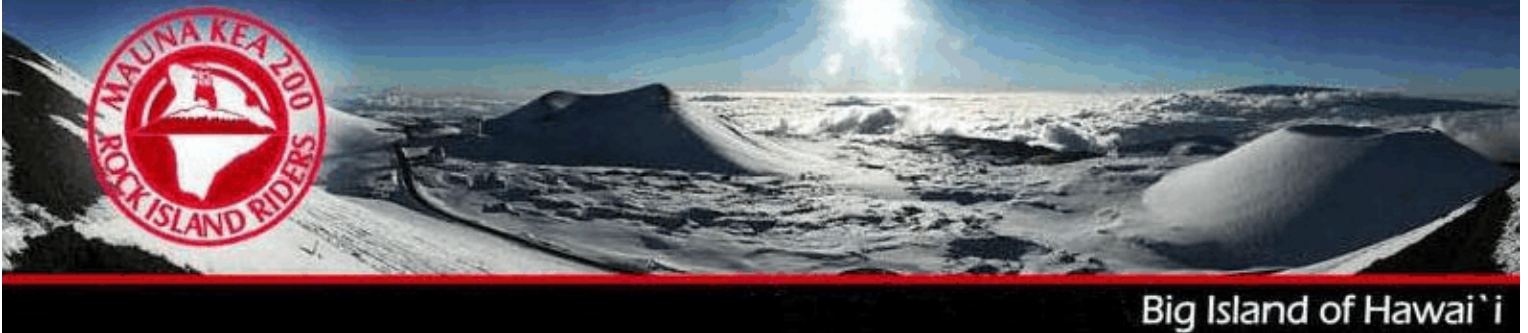


# MAUNA KEA "200" - Motorcycle & ATV Race



## 2012 RIDER REGISTRATION FORM - Information - Page 1 of 4 (v3)

**DATE:** Registration/Rider's Meeting - 5:00pm May 25, 2012 / Event - May 26 & 27, 2012

**COST:** Early registration (by 5/5/12) - Adults \$100, Late registration - \$130 (after 5/5/12). Teams - \$30.

**EVENT DESCRIPTION:** Up to a 165 mile cross country ride over minimally maintained trails and "jeep" roads for motorcycles both Saturday and Sunday. The ATV event will be Sunday only, consisting of 45 miles around Mauna Kea. No time-keeping on Sunday.

The event will be a modified "enduro" format. Scoring is on a points lost system where the lowest score wins. The course will consist of multiple sections which will have a known start and finish control point. A schedule will be provided beforehand which will indicate the starting and finish keytime (scheduled time), length and speed for each section. Your assigned rider number added to the keytime will determine your scheduled time at each checkpoint. To receive zero points for a section you must start at the proper time and finish within the allotted time with all pull-tags. At known checkpoints (eg. section finishes) there is no penalty for arriving up to 15 minutes early. Penalty points will be assigned for leaving a start check at the wrong time or finishing the section late. Being more than 15 minutes early or 60 minutes late will result in an additional 100 point penalty. Missing a checkpoint altogether will result in a 300 point penalty for every missed checkpoint. The club reserves the right to "hour out" riders at any point in the trail due to time constraints on the course. This will be used only as absolutely necessary. An hour out will result in missed checkpoint penalties for subsequent checkpoints. To minimize ties, a limited number of "secret checks" and "special tests" will be used to assign additional points. Secret checks are check points at which you must arrive within the exact minute of your assigned time to zero. Special tests are short race sections where the fastest time wins. While "secret checkpoints" are not shown on the schedule, there will be warning flags on the course before the checkpoint. The time-keeping aspects will be very easy. While a resettable odometer and a watch will be required, a roll chart will be an unnecessary luxury and "enduro computers" are specifically not allowed. A cheat-sheet of the schedule and possible secret checkpoints should be all the paperwork required. This will not be a complicated enduro like the '90s and before.

Flow control on the course will be similar to the 2011 event. A score card holder mounted on the front fender will be required. The rider alone will be responsible for keeping track of where to go next, including the number of times in the loops. There will be a series of numbered, manned check points along the way. Riders will proceed from check point #1 to #2, to #3 and so forth until arriving at the finish of the segment or section. Signs on the course will identify the direction of travel for the next check point. The RIR has an adequate supply of score-card holders available for those that do not already have one.

B class riders will ride a somewhat shorter course.

There will be team competition again this year for the 'A' class only. Teams consist of three A class riders. They need not be in the same sub-class. Team members will ride together on the same number (minute) distinguished by the number suffix a,b,c. Each team will be scored based on the combined scores of its three members.

For those who have never run an enduro before, don't worry, you can do it. Full explanations and a question-and-answer section will be maintained on our website, [mk200.com](http://mk200.com).

On 5:00 pm Friday, May 25 a sign-up, mandatory rider's meeting and late registration will be at the Gilbert Carvalho Park in Hilo.

On Saturday the event will start and finish at the Upper Waiakea ATV/Dirt Bike Park off Stainback Highway.

On Sunday the event will start and finish at Mauna Kea State Park on Saddle Road.

Event headquarters, entertainment and awards ceremony will be located Sunday at Mauna Kea State Park.

Medical insurance will not be provided. If a rescue is required (eg. helicopter or ambulance), participant will be responsible for all costs.

**RIDING NUMBERS:** Riding numbers will be assigned starting with 1 based on a random drawing to be held after the early entry deadline. Team entries will be assigned the next available minute with payment of the team registration fees and at least one rider entry. The team fee is non-refundable. All motorcycles must have front, left and right plate numbers. Quads are permitted to have only two plates. This requirement will be enforced at the tech inspections. Riding numbers will be assigned and posted on the web site. No numbers are being sold this year at registration. Bring your own.

**GAS CHECKS:** Gas checks will be located within 40 miles of the start, finish or another gas check. There are two gas locations planned on both Saturday and Sunday. We recommend 2ea 2.5 gal cans on each day.

**EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:** \* Water and jacket recommended. \* Gas must be in DOT approved fuel containers in like-new condition, clearly marked with your rider number. \* 3 number plates for motorcycles, 2 for quads. \* US Forestry approved spark arrester mufflers are an absolute must! \* **Street legal motorcycle is not required.** \* Appropriate rider apparel, helmet, gloves, long sleeve jersey, riding pants and boots. All machines will have to be tech inspected before being allowed in the starting line. A sticker will be applied by the tech inspector to indicate a successful inspection. Motorcycles will be inspected again at the finish. Penalty points will be assigned for missing required equipment. Required equipment: Approved muffler/spark-arrester, and number plates.

### **CLASSES:**

Motorcycle event:

A class - Team Overall, Individual Overall, Displacement classes: 0-200cc, 201-300cc, 301cc-open, Vet (40-49), Masters (50+), Women. Up to five places in all categories.

B class - Individual Overall, Displacement classes: 0-200cc, 201-300cc, 301cc-open, Vet (40-49), Masters (50+), Women. Up to three places in all categories.

ATV event: Overall. Up to five places.

(Number of places in each class will be determined by the entries received by the early registration cut-off date.

Awards will not compound, eg. overall award winners will not also take disp, age or sex category awards. The number of award places will be adjusted downward based upon the number of entries in each category at the time of the early registration cut-off.

**TIMES:** The exact times may be changed, but the following times can be used as a guide. There will be no other sign-up location or time; all registration will be on Friday only!

\* Sign-up, Rider's Meeting 5:00pm, Friday, May 25.

\* Saturday Tech Inspection 7:00-7:30am, start 8:00am. Bring your gas cans to the tech.

\* Gas can drop off for Sunday will be at Mauna Kea State Park Sunday morning prior to 6:00am.

\* Sunday Tech Inspection 7:00am, start 8:00am.

I (we) hereby give up all of my rights to sue or make any claim whatsoever and do indemnify and hold harmless the State of Hawai'i, Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, County of Hawai'i, United States Army and all land owners and lessees, etc. used in this event, Rock Island Riders, their agents, officers, members, employees, contractors, lessees and their heirs or assigns from and against any and all loss, liability, claims, demands or causes of actions of any nature whatsoever arising out of the entry into this event.

I (we) also release the above organizations from any damages to or theft of my (our) motorcycle or its accessories, whether by fire, accidents or any other causes during, before or after the event. It is further understood that I (we) accept all risks inherent in these events and all risks which exist.

Furthermore, I (we) understand and agree that in the event I am injured from whatsoever cause during the event, I (we) hereby consent to and authorize aid and ambulance service as needed and agree to hold all parties harmless from any consequences of said aid. I agree that I will be responsible for the cost of said aid.

I (we) agree to comply with all rules and sanctions of the organizers of this event. I (we) also release the above organizations of all responsibility for any and all violations of county, state, or federal laws I (we) may knowingly or unknowingly violate.

I (we) also assume full responsibility for any and all damages and injuries caused by myself, my rider or passenger, or agent, representative or servant acting on my behalf during, before and after the days of the event.
